



LOST YOUR PET?

1

- Does your pet have a microchip?
- Does your pet have a collar w/ tags on?
- Notify the microchip company that your pet is lost. Notify the veterinarian where your pet was vaccinated as well. Make sure contact info is up to date.

- Check with your closest neighbors. Often times the pet won't have gone far.
- Post your pet's photo on neighborhood Facebook & Homeowners pages
- Post on community sites such as Nextdoor. Post on Craigslist Lost & Found
- Post your lost pet on the Helotes Humane Society Facebook page and our website's Lost & Found page

- Make flyers to post in your neighborhood. Be sure to include when/where pet was lost, pet's age, breed, color, sex and include a current photo. Include your contact information.

- Call local veterinarians, animal control agencies and the Helotes Humane Society to let them know your pet is missing. Give them a flyer.
- If you live in San Antonio be sure to visit the San Antonio Animal Care Services **in person** and look through the kennels for your pet.

- If someone calls claiming to have your pet, make sure to meet them in a safe place such as a pet store to identify and reclaim.
- **Don't Give Up!** Check back with your contacts and re-post your ads!
